No Electronics during camp hours, unless specified by an instructor or counselor Cell phones and other electronic devices are to be turned off and remain in backpacks at all times during camp hours, unless in an emergency situation.

We expect nothing but fun and frolicking for all of our campers. However, we do know that on occasion there may be behaviors that need to be addressed. We will do this in a kind and direct manner.

Should the behaviors continue, PCA staff members will contact the parent/guardian to discuss any and all issues regarding the situation. If all reasonable attempts have been made and PCA staff determines they do not resolve the issue within our guidelines; PCA reserves the right to dismiss the camper from the remainder of camp.

In the unlikely event a dismissal occurs within the first week, PCA will refund camp fees up to 25%.
